## OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOU!

Why play in only league competition?

You and your team are registered with the Southern Ohio Adult Soccer Association. It makes you a member of the United States Adult Soccer Association also. It makes you a part of the United States Soccer Federation (U S Soccer) and of FIFA. There are many opportunities to test your competitive level.

All teams in SOASA are eligible to play in the **FOUNDER'S CUP**. It is a great chance to play teams from other leagues, meet old friends and make new ones. The 2009 tournament is set for June 20-21 at the Ankeney Soccer Complex, Beavercreek, OH, just east of Dayton. You are scheduled three short games on Sat. The top teams in the preliminaries go on to play in the semis and finals on Sunday. Rules are found on [www.soasa.com](http://www.soasa.com) Look on the left side for Downloads and Rules

Your team might also want to enter the **USASA NATIONAL CUPS** You can enter in one or more of the divisions: Men's Open, Amateur, Under 23, Over 30; Women's Cup and the Under 23. You play in intrastate competition if there is more than one team entered from SOASA in your division. The winners go to play in the Region Cup Finals in Chicago on June 26-28. Region winners play in the National Finals in Orlando, FL, July 24-26. Then there is the **SOASA CUP** to determine the State Champion. The top two teams in your Men's league are invited to compete in a tournament (Ankeney Soccer Complex) on July 11-12. The top teams are eligible to go on to the **MIDWEST REGION TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS** It will be held in Ft. Wayne, IN on Aug 1-2. Women, U-23 and Coed teams are also eligible to compete at the TOC.
